## **Building Permits**

## Valley County does not issue countywide building permits.

## County Permits required:

- If you live near a river, you may need a Floodplain Permit from the County Floodplain Administrator in the Sanitation Department.
- If you will not be hooked up to a public wastewater system, you will need a septic permit from the Valley County Sanitation Department.
- If your house is located outside a platted subdivision, you will need an Access Encroachment Permit from the Valley County Commissioner's Office.

This is a list of county permits only. You may need other federal and state permits as well.

If you are not on a public water supply, you will need a well permit "water right". Contact the DNRC for more information.

A state building permit is required prior to the start of construction for any non-exempt building.

Exempt buildings: farm and ranch buildings residential buildings containing less than five dwelling units, private garages and private storage buildings used for the owner's own use (not part of a commercial enterprise or business). mining buildings on mining property

petroleum refineries and pulp and paper mills (except office and shop buildings)

If you are in Glasgow please contact the City Engineer, Robert Kompel for zoning and building permits.

In Fort Peck, contact the Fort Peck Town Office for permits and zoning. In Nashua, contact the Nashua Town Office for permits and zoning.
